Pyramid has worked for Rinker Materials since 1999, and has performed several tasks including soil excavation of form release oil from a RCP manufacturing facility, preparation of Integrated Spill Plans, SPCC Plans, stormwater sampling at multiple facilities, Air Permitting at three concrete pipe manufacturing facilities in NC, and preparation of Environmental Compliance Guidance Documents for 68 concrete facilities in 22 different States.

Rinker Materials contacted Pyramid and requested the development of a Regulatory Compliance manual for 68 separate facilities in 22 States. Seventy copies of the manuals were needed for a company meeting approximately two weeks from the project start date. The purpose of the manual was to provide the Corporate Health and Safety Manager and each facility manager with a compliance guide that would assist them with air, stormwater, and wastewater compliance at each facility. The compliance manual provided a summary of the State and Federal regulations for each category in each state. The books included managerial responsibilities, permitting flow charts, site-specific contact information, “real” examples of State and Federal programs and permit requirements, site-specific sampling protocols, regulatory and inspection forms and suggested Best Management Practices (BMPs).



The information was compiled in a 3-ring binder with flow charts and contact information to assist managers with regulatory compliance. Each document included a CD with the entire written manual so revisions could be made as facility personnel. Pyramid researched, compiled information & contacts, and assembled 70 manuals within two weeks of receiving authorization to proceed and delivered the documents to the location of Rinker’s annual health and safety meeting on time and on budget.
