



## Site Assessment & Remediation for Federal Trust Fund Projects

### 2009-Present

The Division of Waste Management (DWM), Underground Storage Tank (UST) Section of the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources (NCDENR) requires general environmental service providers to support and/or conduct assessment and remediation activities at leaking underground storage tank (LUST) sites in the Federal and State-Lead programs throughout the State of North Carolina. Pyramid Environmental was awarded a 3 year contract to perform these services for NCDENR based on our professional qualifications and long-standing relationship with the state of North Carolina. The majority of these Federal Trust Fund projects (funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) included the following work items:

- Background data collection, supply well and water line surveys, and preliminary site visits.
- Possible emergency response actions at sites
- Arrangement, scheduling, and oversight of initial remedial activities
- Various hydrogeologic assessment activities at sites
- Arrangement, scheduling, and oversight of various alternate water supply systems
- Preparation and implementation of site-specific Corrective Action Plans, including evaluation of various remedial alternatives and an assessment of the technical feasibility and cost-effectiveness of preferred alternatives; development of design drawings and bid documents for remedial systems
- Management and oversight of subcontractors and vendors
- Preparation of all required permit applications for the construction and operation of various remedial systems
- Oversight of the design and implementation of various strategies for provision of long-term alternate water supplies
